

Johnston Cup

The Men's Club board has decided to add a new event this season as an incentive for participation in the tournament schedule. Much like the FedEx Cup series in the PGA, points will be awarded based upon participation as well as placing in the 5 Men's Club events. These events are highlighted on The Highlands Men's Club Event Schedule.

The points and winners will be awarded as follows:

Participation in Men's Club tournament = 100 Points

Top 10 Overall Net Scores:

1st Place	=	500 Points
2nd Place	=	411 Points
3rd Place	=	347 Points
4th Place	=	293 Points
5th Place	=	251 Points
6th Place	=	216 Points
7th Place	=	188 Points
8th Place	=	165 Points
9th Place	=	147 Points
10th Place	=	132 Points

A player's points for placing in the tournament will be added to his 100 participation points for his total count for that tournament. At the end of the season, the player with the most accumulated points will be the winner of the Johnston Cup.

* In the event of a tie, each player will be awarded the amount of points for the higher placing.

* The overall net scores will be used at the end of a two day event.

* Both players will be awarded the full amount of points for a two person event.
